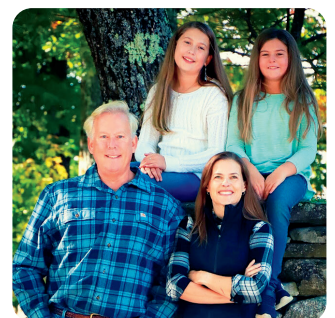

# EDUCATION

The education department at the SLA sure was busy in 2022! Here's the year in review:

In 2022 we shared our knowledge, passion, and care for the Squam Watershed with **1,209 people** through our education programs.

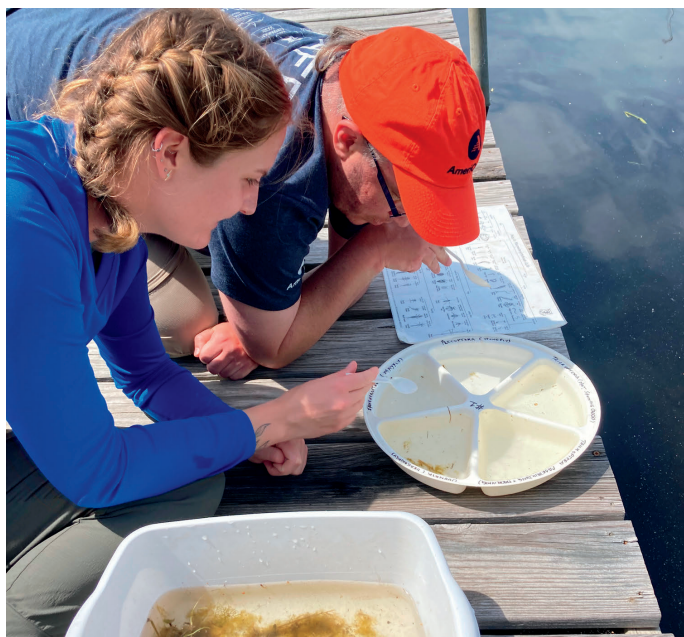
**Afterschool education programs** held at the Holderness School reached **201 students**, teaching them about nature, ecology, and Squam through fun games and activities. Students often suggested topics they were interested in learning about the week before the program. **183 students** came to the SLA to learn about nature in the Squam Watershed and left with a better understanding of how our little piece of Earth relates to the bigger ecological picture!

In collaboration with Squam Lakes Conservation Society and Squam Lakes Natural Science Center, our **Science Pubs** were back in person, held at Walter's Basin in Holderness, NH. They reached **216 attendees**, who could grab some dinner from food trucks available before each session!

**Adventure Ecology** and **Guided Hikes** remain popular with a total of **183 participants!** **Nature Inspired Art Programs**, which are great for all ages, had a total of **25 participants**. Some of the topics included: decomposers, intro to field sketching, guided birding & fishing trips, winter tree identifying, stargazing, mindfulness, and Squam trivia.

**232 campers** joined us for Junior Squam Lakes Association (JSLA), deepening their connection to Squam through hiking, camping, and paddling.

Pam Smith, an artist from Art Haven Studio in Enfield, NH came to the SLA to lead a nature inspired block printing workshop for **8 attendees**. It was given a lot of great feedback so we hope to do similar events in the future!

# LAKES REGION CONSERVATION CORPS

*The Lakes Region Conservation Corps is an AmeriCorps service program that places members at environmental nonprofits throughout the Lakes Region. Members help drive conservation missions forward at their nonprofit host site, and are prepared with the certifications and experiences relevant to continue in the environmental field.*



Milfoil removal efforts hit the ground running, with LRCC dive teams committing over **1,046 crew hours** on surveying and removal efforts, pulling over **1,443 gallons of variable milfoil** from over **35 acres** in Squam Lake, Little Squam, and the Squam River over the course of the season.

The LRCC spent over **1,699 crew hours** on trail work, covering over **107 miles** within the SLA's trail network. Many of those crew hours were committed to the work on Old Bridle Path (see page 22 for more information.)

The SLA's LRCC members developed and led **94 education programs**, reaching **664 people**.



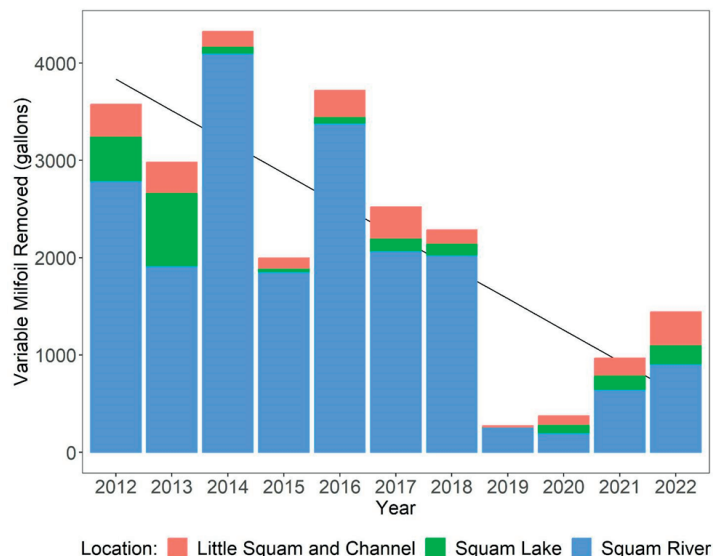
The LRCC program relies on partnerships in many ways, from hosting LRCC members, to providing training and education opportunities to members. This year, LRCC members gave back to some of these partnerships through service days to support the efforts of a variety of organizations, including but not limited to: Sunapee Lake Protective Association with restoration planting; North Conway Community Center with grounds clean-up; Got Lunch, a program aimed at providing healthy lunches to school aged children during the summer months. We are grateful for the many partnerships that make this program possible!

The LRCC program successfully prepared **26 individuals** with valuable experience and certifications relevant to the field of conservation. Program participants leave with the skills and confidence necessary to continue growing towards a career in the field, furthering the reach of the mission of conservation as they pursue positions all over the country.



# CONSERVATION

From 2012 to 2018, our divers removed an average of 3,566.25 gallons of milfoil from the Squam lakes and Squam River. Between 2019 and 2022 we removed an average of 765.33 gallons of milfoil, 75% less than our average over the first six years. This success is incredible!



Our proven track record of successful milfoil removal was an integral part of securing funds from the NH State Conservation Commission through the Moose Plate Conservation grant. This money allows us to build a completely new dive boat and Diver Assisted Suction Harvesting (DASH) system. This boat will be more efficient, made out of lighter, more durable materials, and have an electric motor. A lighter, electric system will increase efficiency, utilize our solar panel generated electricity, and reduce our program's reliance on gasoline.

As 2022 came to a close, the first planning phase of Watershed Management Plan and campaign implementation was well underway. Many restoration projects were designed to focus on stormwater mitigation, in-lake and source water phosphorus reduction, and private shorefront property best management. Along with implementation plans coming together, so did the planning of a state-of-the-art water quality laboratory space that will allow the SLA to bolster water quality monitoring and research projects to identify pivotal ways to secure the quality and quantity of water for the future.

## VOLUNTEERING

Residents of High Haith took part in the Weed Watcher program, led by George and Susan Gurney. This volunteer effort is key to invasive species monitoring and increasing stewardship among the lake's users. Thank you to those who participated!

**182 volunteers** gave over **1,199 hours** of their time and service to contribute to SLA's mission in education, conservation, and trails & access.

Throughout the year, **26 Water Quality monitors** gave **241 hours** on the lakes to contribute to our 40+ year water quality data collection.

**102 volunteers** went out, rain or shine, to perform **397 hours** of trail maintenance on SLA's network of sustainable trails. **29 of those volunteers are our Trail Adopters**, who have committed to independently maintain their chosen trails throughout the year.





## TRAILS & ACCESS

In June, work on Old Bridle Path began with the first Student Conservation Association crew. The SCA AmeriCorps served three separate ten-day stints on Old Bridle Path for a total of 30 days on the trail. The six person SCA crews focused on the highly technical work adjacent to the summit. The three SCA crews completed a roughly 30' log ladder structure, five box steps, four check steps, and roughly 550 board feet of retaining wall. A seven-person University of New Hampshire crew and a three person Lakes Region Conservation Corps crew worked together for two days on the trail to cut down and peel trees for use as drainages and seventeen check steps.

The SLA hosted a seven-person National Civilian Community Conservation Corps (NCCC) crew in 2022, making this the third year the SLA has hosted NCCC! This crew, trained by Katri Gurney and LRCC member Kaela Wilbur, worked on Old Bridle Path from September 20th through October 13th, installing 23 steps, 6 log drainages, and repairing one rock drainage. The 10th Annual Squam Ridge Race was fantastic! We had LRCC, NCCC and 15 volunteers from the Holderness School Cross Country team assist with set-up. The days leading up to the race were particularly windy and in the span of two days we went from zero trees on the race course to 37! We had 149 participants, which is higher than the average of 134 since the race gained momentum in 2015. We also had some new in-kind sponsors including cider donuts from Cider Bellies, burgers from Wine'ing Butcher, and free calf massages for racers on-site from White Mountain Physical Therapy.

The Pemi Valley chapter of New England Mountain Biking Association (NEMBA) worked on the Whitten Woods mountain bike trail from mid-October to Mid-November with a mini-excavator. Their work built upon the significant efforts of previous NCCC crews who cut the trail corridor. With that foundation laid, the mini-excavator operator was able to make sections of the trail more rideable, add trail features for play, and clear a final section of trail.

The new trailhead kiosks and content were installed at the Brooks Fisher and Mt. Percival trailheads by LRCC members at the end of May. We hope the Mt. Percival kiosk will encourage folks parking there to hike Rattlesnake to use the Morse trail to walk over to the Rattlesnake trailhead instead of walking on the road.

In July, we worked in partnership with the Trails Manager of the US Forest Service Pemi Station to relocate the first 0.1 miles of the Mead Trail alongside the SLA Trail Adopter and two other LRCC members. The relocation moves the trail away from a swampy area that's preceded by a steep slope, over to more gradual and sustainable terrain.





# RESEARCH, PLAN, ACT: THE SQUAM WATERSHED CAMPAIGN

**I**N 2022, the SLA embarked on an aggressive campaign to improve and protect water quality in the Squam Watershed amidst climate change and the myriad of modern pressures facing the lake. We continue to act quickly by implementing the identified projects from our watershed plan, which was created in 2020, and putting in place the best equipment and technology available. These ongoing efforts will allow us to effectively maintain the health of the lakes far into the future. Changes to our lakes are inevitable. But they will be healthy.

## **We have researched...**

With datasets from 1979 onward and conservation efforts dating back to 1904, our lakes are well-studied, which gives us a clear understanding of what needs to be done.

## **We have planned...**

We've spent much time and effort as a community to develop a comprehensive watershed plan with ways to protect and improve water quality.

## **Now it is time to act - decisively and at a large scale.**

Building on the work of those before him, Cole Beale, our new Director of Conservation, is tasked with the effort to quickly roll out projects and best management practices that will be required to secure the watershed for the future. Katri Gurney, Director of Trails & Access, is charged with the rebuilding of existing trails and implementation of new trails, making our access system more robust and available to as many people as possible. The SLA staff is hard at work planning, supporting, and executing our plans, and now we need your support.

## **The SLA is doing four things rigorously and well to preserve and protect water quality.**

### **Thorough testing, monitoring, and preservation of the water quality of the Squam Watershed.**

- We've acquired modern, high-quality field and laboratory equipment for rapid quantitative analysis. Using fluorometers, microscopes, and nutrient auto analyzers, we are now able to quickly assess water quality and judge the effectiveness of restoration activities.
- We have started in-house analysis of chlorophyll and phosphorus in compliance with the US Environmental Protection Agency, NH Department of Environmental Services, and UNH Lakes Lay Monitoring methods.
- The LakeSmart program has been implemented, involving shoreline property site visits, reporting, and restoration project planning.
- We built a new milfoil removal and research vessel in tandem with acquiring a tank-filling system that keeps our divers on the lake for extended periods.



### **Implementation of the Watershed Management Plan to reduce nutrients, contaminants, and sediments throughout the Squam Watershed.**

- Sandwich Beach Erosion Control – We partnered with the Merrimack River Watershed Council, USDA Forest Service, Sandwich Town Parks & Recreation, Town Board, and Conservation Commission to plant over 80 shrubs and saplings to prevent further erosion of the beach.
- Removing nutrients from the water is one of the best ways to walk back the eutrophication of the lake. Starting in hotspots such as Dog Cove, White Oak Pond, Piper Cove, and Little Squam, we are installing bio-islands and in-lake aeration systems to disrupt in-lake nutrients.

### **Improvement of the Squam Lakes trail system to curb erosion, manage storm runoff, and educate the public.**

- Rattlesnake Trails - We hope you've noticed our comprehensive efforts on Rattlesnake which are nearly complete. Read more in depth about Old Bridle Path on page 22.
- Accessible Trail development - We've completed the engineering plan and will start the bidding process for an all-persons accessible wildlife-viewing trail on SLA's campus. A central aspect of this project is access for people with disabilities. There are currently no locations along the shoreline of Squam Lake accessible to people with physical or cognitive disabilities to access Squam's natural beauty.

### **Upgrade SLA buildings and grounds to serve as efficient, effective, sustainable hubs for our programs and the community.**

- We are improving our campus so it becomes a “watershed hub” that educates the public about ecology and supports the community-based activities of the SLA. We have established a plan that integrates green building goals, improves spaces to enhance programming and mission delivery, and provides accessible educational facilities so people of all abilities can explore and learn about Squam.
- We secured a CDFA grant to renovate the SLA campus, which includes our main building and offices, activity barn, and lake access through our waterfront and dock system, which is free and open to the public year-round.

This campaign for the Squam Watershed will improve our capacity, bring our equipment to a level that will make our work against these threats easier and more effective, and increase our outreach and education so that we can all proactively participate in the stewardship of this incredible lake.

**Remaining idle is no longer an option.  
We must act now.**



For the calendar year ending December 31, 2022, net income from operations totaled \$104,538. Our operating revenue was \$1,233,970 with strong contributions, annual giving, grants, and programs. This operating revenue excludes any realized capital gains, or changes to the market value of our investment portfolio, which totaled \$3,736,183 at the end of 2022.

The SLA sources most of its operating revenue from donations and member support (32%), program fees (20.7%), and grants (31.9%) and other income such as store sales and rent (2%). \$165,260 (13.4%) of total operating revenue was derived via funds systematically transferred on a quarterly basis from our Squam Lakes Fund investment account. The proportionality of these income streams track closely to the prior years.

Net assets at December 31, 2022 were \$10,762,730. Our largest asset class continues to be real estate (land and buildings), with a recorded value of \$5.3 million at year end 2022. Also included in our net assets are the marketable investment securities of \$3.7 million.

The investment portfolio is managed to provide recurring income for operations and to fund projects of the organization, while maintaining a balanced risk profile. Our account is primarily comprised of mutual funds and low cost passive funds linked to market indices for public equity and fixed income securities. All of our investment securities have public valuations that are readily available, and are stated at fair market value. Our investment results continue to track broad market indices, weighted relative to our portfolio allocation by asset class.

Our financial statements are audited by Rowley & Associates, P.C. and are prepared based on generally accepted accounting principles for non-profit organizations. We are pleased to report that the SLA has received a clean audit opinion for our financial statements for the 2022 fiscal year. The SLA audited financial statements and footnotes are available on our website.

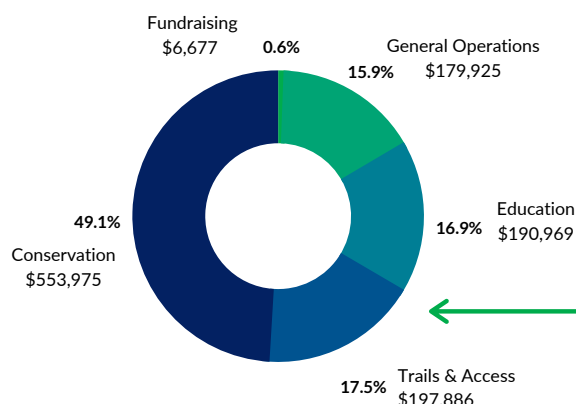

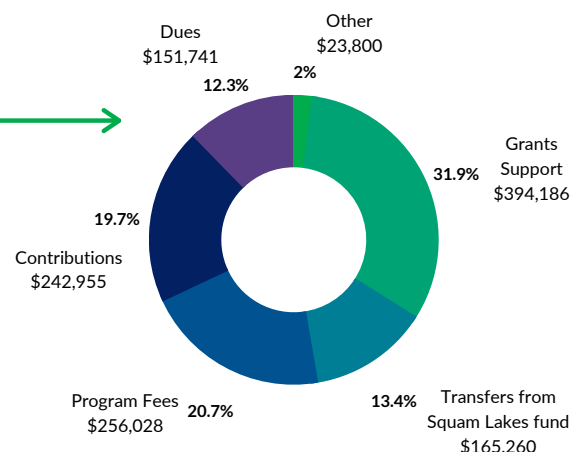

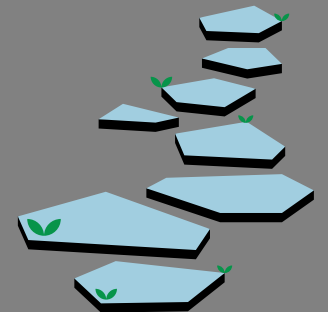

# OLD BRIDLE PATH PROJECT



**T**he Squam Lakes Association tackled an enormous amount of trail maintenance on Old Bridle Path up to West Rattlesnake in 2022! The successes of this work were a combined effort of volunteers, AmeriCorps members, trail crews, and SLA staff. The work was supported by generous donations from the Edwin S. Webster Foundation, University of New Hampshire, Madeline G. Von Weber Trust, New Hampshire Electric Coop, Rockywold Deephaven's Squam Environmental Preservation Fund, and contributions from hikers.

The work kicked off in June 2022 with volunteer and staff workdays. Over eighty people joined to carry 96 one-hundred-pound timbers a mile up to the top of West Rattlesnake! Many of these timbers were carried by LRCC AmeriCorps members and the summer staff of Camp Deerwood. The Camp Deerwood staff outdid themselves by returning over the weekend with a 40-person group to finish carrying the final 40 timbers up trail.

The dedication of all these people allowed the 6-person Student Conservation Association (SCA) trail crew to focus their energy on building structures to reduce erosion and make the trail adjacent to the summit more easily traversed by hikers. The SCA crew spent six weeks on the trail and instal-

led 16 steps, a 20 ft. log ladder step structure (see below), and two 80 linear ft. retaining walls that are 3 ft. maximum in height (see bottom). The difference between the old rotting structures and the new structures is night and day!

Several crews followed, after the SCA completed their work. These crew focused on sections of the trail between miles 0.2 to 0.7. The University of New Hampshire's 7-person crew worked alongside SLA's 3-person crew for two days, helping to install three drainages and one step. The SLA crew remained on the trail for two weeks and completed six more log drainages and seventeen steps. The final crew on the trail was a National Civilian Community Corps AmeriCorps team who were on the trail for three weeks and installed 23 steps, 6 log drainages, and repaired one rock drainage.

All these structures are installed with an eye for minimizing the impact of the annual tens of thousands of hikers on the surrounding ecosystem. As we walk along a trail, the tread of our feet dislodges soil, rocks, and roots. The wearing down of the soil, known as erosion, is one of the biggest impacts on our ecosystem that arises on trails. When hikers walk around structures it causes compaction on either side of the structure, which undermines the soil and rock that keep the structure stable. As you hike along the trail, remain in the trail corridor- please walk on the steps and hike over rather than around the drainage structures. Between all the trail crews and volunteer initiatives over 2,000 hours of work was put into building these structures in 2022 and there's still more work to be done!

The work on Old Bridle Path is expected to be completed in 2023. The Trail Fixing Collective, Northwoods Conservation Center, volunteers, and SLA's crews are working on the trail throughout the 2023 season to complete work on the 0.2 miles of trail adjacent to the trailhead. Keep an eye out for volunteer days in the future to help with the work on the trail!

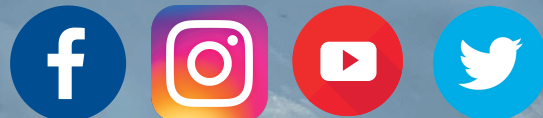
