By matching the work we are already doing we were able to leverage your donations and effectively double their value in work capacity.

2018 was exciting and filled with interesting and meaningful conservation activities. Whether it was putting together the solar project, which here in 2019 is reducing our carbon footprint and saving money, or working with local students on after school programs, our efforts continue to advance each year.




TRAILS & ACCESS

> Our dedicated team of Lakes Region Conservation Corps members and community volunteers spent over 1700 hours managing the SLA trail network doubling our trail crew hours in 2017. > Our LRCC members taught Camp Hale staff about trail ethics and routed the start of a sustainable trail that will eventually loop around their campus. We look forward to continuing our partnership with this wonderful organization. In 2019 they joined as one of the new LRCC host sites. > The Rattlesnake trail network is now color-coded to ease a hiker's ability

to navigate the network.


> We worked with the Town of Holderness and state legislators to get "No Parking" signs installed along NH Route 113 by the Old Bridle Path

trailhead. These signs and the colorcoded blazing will provide a safer environment for hikers in the area.



> We completed the new Brooks Fisher Trail in 2018 and received positive feedback from our hiking community. This trail was designed with sustainability and durability in mind to protect the

area's natural qualities and resources. We thank Tim and Audrey Fisher, the Edwin S. Webster Foundation, and Peter and Faith Coolidge for their generous support.



LAKES REGION CONSERVATION CORPS

- > In 2018 LRCC members devoted 1,752 hours to trail work.
- > 2,283 gallons of milfoil were removed from the Squam Lakes.
- > SLA's education program grew with weekly programs with JSLA, trail work at Camp Hale, and in the Holderness and Plymouth School systems. This allowed us to reach over 400 individuals with our conservation message.
- > The LRCC program expanded with five new host sites including Camp Hale, Green Mountain Conservation Group, Lake Winnipesaukee Association, New Hampshire Lakes, and Newfound Lake Region Association. Continuing partnerships include Lakes Region Conservation Trust and the Squam Lakes Conservation Society.





EDUCATION

- > Through paddling, hiking, swimming, sailing, and environmental education, summer youth program campers develop a strong sense of self, community, and place. 235 youth campers participated in 2018!
- > 1,395 people attended SLA guided hikes, education explorations for all ages, and after school programs.
- > In April 2018 the SLA started an after school program called "Operation Get Outside" at Holderness Central School and expanded to Plymouth Elementary School in November. This weekly program focused on getting students outside exploring nature in their schoolyard. 290 students learned about nature all while playing games and having fun!



CONSERVATION

> We received grant funding to investigate contaminants in the Squam Watershed and worked with an environmental consulting firm to devise and carry out a sampling plan to begin to understand the presence of chemical contaminant in tributary sediment.

- > We piloted a neighborhood Weed Watcher program to further protect the lake from invasive species by scanning the lake bottom for variable milfoil and other aquatic invasives.
- > We made strides toward finishing the Squam Lakes Watershed plan including a watershed survey looking for erosion hot spots and completed the build out analysis, which looks at how much development is possible in the watershed.

VOLUNTEERS

- > In 2018, 189 individual community volunteers gave over 1,600 hours of service to the Squam Lakes Watershed.
- > We completed the High Impact Volunteer Engagement (HIVE) program offered for New Hampshire Center for Nonprofits. During this program SLA staff and LRCC members worked with a professional consultant to enhance SLA's volunteer program as a whole.
- > On the lakes, we've added more water quality sites and are monitoring year-round through the ice in the winter.
- > 94 volunteers spent 329 hours maintaining and growing a network of sustainable trails.
- > A total of 76 hours were spent removing terrestrial invasive plants around the watershed.
- > Loon Chick Watchers spent 80 hours protecting loon families and distributing information to the public.
- > At the Squam Ridge Race, over 70 volunteers helped out before, during and after the event giving over 300 hours to the race.
- > At the Annual Fall Work Day volunteers spent almost 100 hours cleaning up and preparing the SLA's backcountry facilities and campus for winter.

or the calendar year ended December 31, 2018, net revenues from operations totaled \$80,357, relatively unchanged from last year. Our operating revenues, however, grew to \$991,089 due primarily to a grant from the Corporation for National Service's AmeriCorps program. These funds were then utilized to underwrite our Lakes Region Conservation Corps effort. The operating revenues exclude any realized capital gains, or changes to the unrealized gain account for our investment portfolio, which totaled \$3,057,848 at the end of fiscal year 2018.

As in past years, the SLA sources most of its operating revenues from member support (35%), program fees (25%), and grants (24%) and other income such as store sales and rent (3%). Also, \$124,981 (13%) of total operating revenue was derived via funds systematically transferred on a quarterly basis from our Squam Lakes Fund investment account. Other than grants the proportionality of these income streams track closely to the prior year.


The SLA's net assets at December 31, 2018 were \$7,802,560, a decrease compared with the prior year end balance. Our largest asset class is real estate (land and buildings). with a recorded value of \$5.1 million at year end 2018. Also included in our net assets are highly liquid and marketable investment securities of \$3 million which represents a slight decline from 2017 due to the effects of the difficult equity market in 2018. The investment portfolio is managed to provide recurring income for operations and to fund projects of the organization, while maintaining a risk profile that minimizes the probability for the loss of principal. Our investment portfolio is primarily comprised of mutual funds and low cost passive funds linked to market indices for public equity and fixed income securities. All of our investment securities have public valuations that are readily available, and are stated at fair market value. Our investment results continue to track broad market indices, weighted relative to our portfolio allocation by asset class.

Our financial statements are audited by Rowley & Associates, P.C., and are prepared based on generally accepted accounting principles for non-profit organizations. We are pleased to report that the SLA has received a clean audit opinion for our financial statements for the fiscal year 2018. The SLA audited financial statements and footnotes are available on our website.


